Please Note:

***Beginning June 1st, meal pick-up will no longer be available.**

We have been working with District Health Department #10 to ensure everyone's safety, as well as following the CDC guidelines. Please note that things can change very quickly, and OCCOA must abide by the rules set forth by these entities.

If you are fully vaccinated, meaning you have received BOTH shots and it has been more than 14 days since the second shot, a mask is not mandatory. If you are not fully vaccinated, masks are mandatory until further notice. Temperature checks will still be taken. You must also be able to answer no to all health questions posted at the entrance. We are also taking a (voluntary) survey to get a percentage of those who have received their vaccine. If you still would like to receive your vaccine, please let a staff member know, and we can assist with getting you an appointment.
