Fare fee subject to change

Age 60+

Within any zone: \$4.00

From one zone to another zone: \$5.00

All others

Within any zone: \$8.00

From one zone to another zone: \$10.00

Zones determined by Townships:

- Zone A- Pentwater, Weare, Golden, Hart
- Zone B- Benona, Shelby, Claybanks, Grant
- Zone C- Crystal, Colfax, Elbridge, Leavitt
- Zone D- Ferry, Newfield, Otto, Greenwood

Passengers who get off the bus or change destinations will be charged an additional fare.
